Semester Courses

EN201a SOCCER. Coach Hernandez will divide students up by appropriate age groups while they learn the fundamentals of soccer and develop their skills. Modest PE style shorts and t-shirts, soccer shoes, shin guards and a water bottle are required. New soccer students will receive their own soccer ball (included in the registration fee). **Grades K-8. Maximum: 30 students. Mondays & Wednesdays: 3:10-4:10 (Playground). 14 Week Course. Cost: \$170 - begins January 19.**

EN202 KIDS CHOIR. Come and sing! No auditions required. Students will review reading/following choral music and terms. They will learn to sing in two and three part harmony expanding their musical repertoire and performance skills. Cost includes a Choir shirt and end of the semester party. Additional requirements include black pants, black socks, black shoes (sandals for girls). Students will perform in various choral competitions. There will be an optional trip to participate in Disney's Young Performers Workshop at Epcot (additional costs involved). **Grades 3-5. Maximum: 40 students. Wednesdays: 3:00-4:10 (Rm EC215). 14 Week Course. Cost: \$85 - begins January 18.**

CHOI KWANG DO. Choi Kwang Do's natural, easy-to-learn, sequential movements maximize your body's force producing capabilities increasing opportunities to enhance your health. Students will learn to support each other wholeheartedly with positive reinforcement. Students will learn to trust each other in a spirit of faith, support and camaraderie. They will learn to keep a clear, strong mind. Commitment and persistence are key components that the students will learn as they focus on their goals of achievement.

Master D credentials include International Examiner, International Advanced Chief Instructor, International Faculty member (one of eight in the world), 5th Degree Black Belt Master in Choi Kwang Do, highest ranking black belt in the State of Florida, 4th Degree Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do, State certified with the Pinellas County School Board and a member of First Baptist Church of Indian Rocks.

Cost includes student uniform. There is an additional fee for advancement testing at the end of the semester.
