### Home School/Interscholastic Activities and Sports Involvement Policies

Indian Rocks Christian School allows Homeschool students to participate in sports/extracurricular activities as long as these policies and procedures are met:

1. Student must be recognized by the State of Florida as being registered in a Home Education Program at the time of seeking admission to IRCS.
2. Student must be registered with IRCS at the Admissions Office before any sports conditioning, participation on a sports team or other activity begins.
3. Student must attend on-campus chapel service every Thursday.
4. Student must agree to follow IRCS Middle School/High School Student Handbook guidelines.
5. Parent must pay application fee or re-registration fee plus sport/activity fee(s) at the Admissions Office or Finance Office.
6. Parent is responsible to complete/submit all forms listed below with fees and payment before any participation in sports/activity begins:
  - IRCS Admissions Application
  - IRCS Statement of Cooperation and Medical Treatment form
  - FHSAA Forms EL2, EL3, EL7, and for grades 10-12, Form G4A
  - Florida Immunization Form #680
  - Florida Health Physical Form #3040
  - Copy of Birth Certificate

### **Fee Schedule for Homeschoolers**

Admissions Application Fee \$200.00 (first time participants)
Annual Re-registration Fee \$100.00 (all returning students from previous year only)

Sport Activity Fee(s) \$50.00 (per sport)
Extracurricular Activities – see Finance Office for rates
6-8 gr. class tuition 1,100 (per class)/9-12 gr. class tuition 1,200 (per class)

\*Based on the sport/extracurricular/class, there may be additional fees involved during the course of the activity that will be communicated from the coach/teacher to the student/parent.

\*If student fails to make a sports team after trying out, 50% of the application or re-registration fee(s) will be refunded to the parent.
