 - **Statement of Cooperation & Release Forms (provided by school & notarized here)**

1. An entrance test *may* be given to students in K5 – 5th grades to determine grade level readiness.
2. Kindergarten Students Admission Criteria
 - Must be 5 years old on or before September 1 of the school year.
 - Ability of student to adjust to classroom learning.
 - Verification of attending pre-kindergarten program or demonstrate kindergarten readiness
3. Elementary Students Admission Criteria
 - Must be of suitable age for the grade assigned. (1st graders must be six years old on or before September 1st of the school year).
 - Must have ability to adjust to classroom learning.
 - Must be fluent in English.
4. Parent and child will be scheduled for an interview with the appropriate principal. During the interview the Principal will review the school's history, philosophy, curriculum, discipline system, homework expectations, communication, etc. The Principal will discuss the child's academic, spiritual, social and physical needs with the parents. **(Registration is not completed until the student has been interviewed by the principal, formally accepted, and a signed financial agreement submitted by parents, which affirms the parents decision to enroll their child).** After the interview the decision of the admission will be made as soon as possible.

5. Families must agree to abide by school policies, assist the school and support school officials in the implementation and enforcement of its policies.

6. Each student of the school shall be of the highest moral character and be obedient to all biblical principles. All students must obey the laws of the United States of America and the State of Florida and all local ordinances. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student with or without cause.

C. Selection Process

Selection of students for acceptance will be based on the following criteria as evidenced through the admission application and interview:

- Students must demonstrate a desire to succeed academically as evidenced by current and prior grade reports.
- Students who are open to hearing the gospel of Christ.
- Students must demonstrate acceptable conduct and good behavior as evidenced on recent and prior report card behavior evaluation.
- The student and family must be willing to work in close partnership with Indian Rocks Christian School as evidenced by signing appropriate form in the Parent/Student Handbook, and the Statement of Cooperation Form.
- IRCS does not accept students who have been expelled, suspended or reassigned from other schools.
- IRCS does not accept students who have used illegal drugs and are coming directly out of a drug treatment program.

Priority of acceptance is determined by the following criteria:

- Pupils currently enrolled and continuing at Indian Rocks Christian School. This protected enrollment expires at the end of the annually announced re-enrollment period for present students. This usually occurs in January. Currently enrolled students have a limited time to re-enroll on a priority basis. Acceptance for re-enrollment is contingent on the level of academic and citizenship performance attained during the previous enrollment period and meeting all financial obligations.
- Children of staff members of IRCS and FBCIR
- Children of members of First Baptist Church of Indian Rocks
- Siblings in families who already have one or more children in the school.
- All other applications will be held in a “waiting pool” for review.

D. Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment begins the third week in January. A packet of information will be sent home to each current family detailing the enrollment process.

Students must have verification of an average Total Stanine score of five with a score of four or better in each major academic area on prior year achievement tests. **All new students are considered on probation (academic, social) for the first semester.** Before applying for admission, please review your child's academic records in light of the above criteria. Students must be fluent in English to attend school at IRCS.

For those students transferring in during the school year, an investigation is conducted as to the reasons for transferring, performance and conduct while at the previous school, along with achievement test scores and progress reports. Students removed (expelled, suspended, reassigned, etc.) from another school are not accepted within a year of expulsion.

1. An admissions test *may* be given to students in 6-12 grades.
2. Parent and child will be scheduled for an interview with the appropriate principal. During the interview the Principal will review the school's history, philosophy, curriculum, discipline system, homework expectations, communication, etc. They will also discuss the child's academic, spiritual, social and physical needs with the parents. **(Registration is not completed until the student has been interviewed by the principal, formally accepted and a signed financial agreement submitted by parents).** After the interview the decision of the admission will be made as soon as possible. Parents affirm their decision to enroll the student in the school by submitting a signed Financial Agreement
3. Families must agree to abide by school policies, assist the school and support school officials in the implementation and enforcement of its policies.
4. Each student of the school shall be of the highest moral character and be obedient to all biblical principles, including, but not limited to, prohibitions against fornication, drug use, alcohol use, pornography and homosexuality. All students must obey the laws of the United States of America and the State of Florida and all local ordinances. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student with or without cause.

Selection of students for acceptance will be based on the following criteria as evidenced through the admission application and interview:

- Students must demonstrate a desire to succeed academically as evidenced by current and prior grade reports.

CLOTHING STANDARDS:

Students are permitted to wear the following to school:

1. IRCS monogrammed knit shirts purchased at Allen Sports Center.
2. IRCS monogrammed Oxford-style shirts purchased at Allen Sports Center.
3. Shirts must be properly fitted and tucked in.
4. Solid navy blue, gray or khaki walking length uniform shorts & dress slacks
5. Plain denim jeans that fit properly. Extra wide legged or baggy, low hanging jeans are not permitted. Deep pockets, cargo jeans or decorated jeans are not permitted.
6. Safe, secure rubber-soled shoes are to be worn. (Athletic style shoes are preferred.) No sandals, “cros”, plastic, wheeled or platform style shoes are permitted.
7. All students must wear neat clean socks.
8. Belts must be worn if there are belt loops (1st –5th grade)
9. Solid colored sweaters that are V-neck, crew neck or cardigan with an IRCS collared school shirt underneath.
10. Indian Rocks Christian School sweatshirts with an IRCS collared school shirt underneath.
11. Long-sleeved turtleneck shirts under an IRCS school shirt.
12. All outerwear (sweatshirts, jackets, etc.) worn in the classroom must be school-approved IRCS outerwear.
13. All shirts **MUST** be **tucked in** properly.

In addition Girls are permitted to wear the following to school:

1. Hosiery/tights
2. Solid navy blue, khaki or gray modest length uniform skirts, uniform jumpers, uniform skorts, uniform culottes, uniform capris or monogrammed uniform dresses.

JEWELRY:

Boys and girls may wear appropriate, but not overstated jewelry; questionable or anti-Christian jewelry is prohibited. Bracelets and necklaces are acceptable for boys. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.

HAIR STANDARDS: Traditional modest haircuts are required as outlined in the parent-student handbook.

CLOTHING STANDARDS:

Males and Females are permitted to wear the following only:

1. IRCS monogrammed knit shirts purchased at Allen Sports Center.
2. IRCS monogrammed Oxford-style shirts purchased at Allen Sports Center.
3. Slacks and uniform walking shorts must be a solid color. Administration reserves the right to disapprove colors that are non-traditional, extreme, distracting, etc.
4. Plain, traditional 4 or 5 pocket denim jeans or traditional khakis that fit properly. Extra wide legged or baggy, low hanging pants are not permitted. Deep pockets or cargo pants are not permitted.
5. Clean, neat dress shoes, or clean, neat, properly laced athletic shoes and western boots. All shoes/sandals must have manufactured backs or manufactured back straps.
6. Indian Rocks Christian School sweatshirts with an IRCS collared school shirt underneath.
7. All outerwear (sweatshirts, jackets, etc.) worn in the classroom must be school-approved IRCS outerwear.
8. Long sleeved turtleneck shirts under an IRCS collared school shirt.

In Addition:

10. Socks, if worn by girls, should be matching and coordinated with clothing.
11. Socks must be worn by male students.
12. Belts **MUST** be worn.
13. All shirts **MUST** be **tucked in** properly.
14. Hats are not to be worn in the building.
15. Clothing with offensive slogans, writing of any kind, symbols or pictures is not acceptable.
16. Christian T-shirts worn on Fridays must be distinctively Christian in design, pictures and wording.
17. All team, band and other specialty, collared shirts may be worn **only** on game days, performance days, club meeting days or Fridays.
18. No team jerseys are to be worn during school without administrative approval.
19. PE shirt and shorts must be purchased at Allen Sports Center.

JEWELRY:

Indian Rocks Christian School adopts the historic Christian view of life as presented in the Bible. Since God created and sustains everything through His Son, Jesus Christ, the world and life are God-centered and should glorify Him. Man, being a sinner by nature and choice, cannot glorify or know God apart from being recreated in God's image through committing his life to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. The total process of education, therefore, must seek a restoration of the pupil to a position of true knowledge, righteousness and holiness in Christ by relating the whole person to God spiritually, mentally, socially, and physically. All truth is God's truth and must be integrated into every area of school life. Such education is primarily the parents' responsibility, and the school functions as an extension of the home to aid the parents in providing this education.

From this philosophy stem certain educational objectives:

I. FOR THE SPIRITUAL AND MORAL GROWTH OF THE STUDENTS, the school seeks:

- To lead the pupils into a personal, saving relationship with Christ as Lord and Savior,
- To teach the essential doctrines of the Christian faith,
- To develop a desire to know and to do the will of God,
- To teach the students consistent daily Christian living and service,
- To develop a biblical sense of right and wrong,
- To foster self-discipline in the student based on respect for and reverence toward God and all authority, and
- To help pupils develop a consistent Christian philosophy of life by integrating all subjects with the Bible.

II. FOR THE PERSONAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE STUDENTS, the school strives:

- To develop in pupils a balanced personality based on a proper understanding and acceptance of themselves and others as God made them,
- To foster wholesome personal relationships through development of social skills based on the Christian concept of love,
- To prepare the student for wholesome and Christian use of leisure time,
- To demonstrate a biblical view of life, work, and occupational endeavors,
- To develop the proper attitudes, understanding and skills needed to establish God-honoring homes,
- To promote fitness, maintenance, and skillful use of the body as the temple of God, and to impart the biblical attitude toward material things.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM

K2 – 8th Grade

ADMISSION POLICY

Only students of working parents enrolled in Indian Rocks Christian School in K2 through 8th grade are eligible for enrollment in our After School Program. IRCS After School Program charges may be paid annually in advance or on a monthly basis in advance. These monthly payments are the same regardless of student attendance, and payments will be calculated on the financial agreement. The IRCS After School Program is not a drop-in program. Students not picked up after school within fifteen minutes of dismissal will be admitted into the After School Program. The After School Program is only open when Indian Rocks Christian School is in session. Please check the school calendar on www.ircs.org for holidays.

LATE PICK-UP CHARGES

A \$15.00 penalty fee will be charged for each 15 minutes your child is left past 6:00 p.m.

A \$5.00 minimum fee will be charged for students not enrolled in the After School Program and not picked up within 15 minutes of dismissal. Parents will be charged an additional \$5.00 per half-hour or any part of a half-hour thereafter. There will be a maximum charge of \$15 per day until 6:00 p.m. for these students.

DAYS OF OPERATION

The IRCS After School Program begins the first day of the 2009-2010 school year.

K2 – 5th grade ASC will be open when IRCS is in session.

Middle School ASC will be open only when IRCS is in session for a full day.

An approved school calendar will be available on www.ircs.org in the early spring.

Financial Policies 2009-2010

The annual tuition provides the operating funds for Indian Rocks Christian School. Financial responsibility is one of the key factors in maintaining a quality Christian school for your child. Your cooperation will enable Indian Rocks Christian School to maintain a positive Christian testimony by having the funds necessary to meet our financial obligations in a timely manner.

Registration Fee – The registration fee must accompany the Re-enrollment or New Enrollment Application. This fee is non-refundable unless the child is not accepted for enrollment.

Annual Tuition – Please refer to the *Fee Schedule* for current prices. A Financial Agreement will be completed during the enrollment process that will establish the contracted financial obligation as well as a payment plan.

Tuition Discounts – Multiple child discounts are applicable for two or more siblings on the same Financial Agreement. Please refer to the *Fee Schedule* for sibling discounts. Multiple child discounts shall be based on the number of siblings enrolled at any given time.

Payment Plans – Payment plans are available and may be arranged through the Finance Office. Parents may elect to pay the annual tuition, in full, in advance, by July 1, and receive a prepayment discount off of tuition. As a convenience, the annual tuition may be paid in (10) or (12) equal installments: 12-month plan (June-May) or 10-month plan (August-May). All monthly payment plans require a \$45 non-refundable payment plan setup fee due upon completion of the Financial Agreement.

Payment Methods – If you have selected **Payment in Full**, please mail your payment directly to Indian Rocks Christian School, 12685 Ulmerton Rd, Largo, FL 33774. If you have selected the **Monthly ACH Payment Plan**, an ACH account will be setup with FACTS Management Company which specializes in payment processing and serves Indian Rocks Christian School for all monthly payment plans.

Late Fees – Partial payments or payments received after the due date will result in a late charge of \$25.00. If the due date falls on a weekend or holiday, the payment will be considered timely if received on the next business day.

Returned Payment Fee (NSF) – There will be a \$25.00 per item fee on returned payments. Returned checks or automatic withdrawals will be re-attempted up to two additional times.

Delinquent Accounts – For Monthly Payment Plan accounts, if more than (2) payments are delinquent; class attendance will not be permitted until arrangements have been made to have the account brought to a current status.

Fines/Debts – From time to time, fines or debts may be incurred. Fines or debts include, but are not limited to, overdue or lost library books, damaged or lost textbooks, lunches, before and after school drop-in charges, or damage to church or school property. The Finance Office will send statements on a monthly basis to inform you of these charges. Payments for fines or debts should be made directly to Indian Rocks Christian School. Do not send payments for fines or debts to FACTS.

Withdrawal Policy – A student withdrawn prior to August 1st of the new school year is eligible for a full refund of prepaid tuition only. The registration fee will not be refunded except as noted above. Should a student be withdrawn after school has begun, for any reason, the account must be in a current status and a 20% early withdrawal fee will be imposed on the remaining annual tuition. Prepayment discounts will be forfeited upon early withdrawal and deducted prior to any refunds.

The school will not release student records to another school or to parent(s) until all financial obligations have been paid in full.

Additional financial policies are stated on the Financial Agreement.
