Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Depart for Europe! Overnight flight to Frankfurt, Germany.

Day 2: Arrive the following day and meet your guide in Frankfurt. Transfer to the charming university town of Heidelberg where we will visit the large castle, one of finest examples of Germany's Gothic-Renaissance architecture. Free time for shopping.

Day 3: In the morning depart for the magical medieval-walled city of Rothenberg. Walk the city walls, go shopping, or opt for the Torture Museum. In the afternoon depart for Munich, the capital of Bavaria.

Day 4: Travel to Dachau, where we will tour the WWII concentration camp outside of Munich. We will also visit famous sites and shops in the central historical district, including the Altes Rathaus, Marienplatz, and the Viktualienmarkt (a large open market). Depart in the afternoon for Garmisch – Partenkirchen, a beautiful Bavarian town located on the German-Austrian border. A highlight of our afternoon will be departing from the site of the 1936 Winter Olympic Games to hike up the incredible gorge called Partnachlam.

Day 5: After breakfast, we will go to the top of the world as we take the cogwheel train to the Zugspitze peak and then the cable ride down (the steepest in Europe). While at the top of the mountain, look across the peaks of the German, Austrian, Italian, and Swiss Alps. From 10,000 feet high, send an email to your family back home! After our descent, enjoy scenic Lake Eibsee. After lunch in Garmisch, take a short drive to the end of the famous Romantic Road to the area around Fussen. While there we will visit the spectacular Newshwanstein Castle built by Mad King Ludwig.

Day 6: Stopping at beautiful sites along the way, cross the border into Austria en route to Switzerland. In the morning stop at Innsbruck for a brief walking tour and to see remnants of the winter Olympics. Afternoon stop in Vaduz, the capital of the small country of Lichtenstein. Journey through Switzerland and the European Alps arriving in Lucerne in the evening.

Day 7: Enjoy a walking tour of Lucerne including the Lowendenkmal, the famous lion monument to the Swiss guards killed in the French Revolution. Stroll across the Kapellbrücke Bridge while admiring the ancient walls and watchtowers of the old town.

Day 8: After our once-in-a-lifetime experience, fly back home from Zurich!
