Why Do We Have a Dress Code?

At IRCs, we want you to make good choices.

Events should be fun, but we want everyone to be comfortable and safe.

Students are asked to dress modestly and appropriately.

The following guidelines are provided for students and parents to know what the school expects.

The following rules and guidelines apply to both Indian Rocks Christian School students and their dates. It is the responsibility of the students of IRCS to inform their dates of these guidelines.

1

Dresses may not be cut below the bust line.



This dress meets dress code.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESSES



Front necklines of female students must not be lower than five inches from the base of the neck. Hemlines should be no shorter than four inches above the knees.

Unacceptable – too short



Hemline no shorter than 4" above the knee

Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the naval.



This dress meets dress code. Please notice how the bust is covered on the sides.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESSES



#3

Midriffs will not be exposed.
This includes both front and side.
With arms down at your side, if flesh
touches flesh in the midriff section,
the dress is inappropriate.

This dress meets dress code.



UNACCEPTABLE DRESSES



#4

Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh. This is fingertip length.

This dress meets dress code.



UNACCEPTABLE DRESSES



While we will be reasonable in our interpretation of these guidelines, we want you to know that you will not be allowed into the event if you are dressed inappropriately. Most importantly, this dress code does not limit your ability to show your style and uniqueness.

There are many beautiful and stylish dresses that do meet dress code.



Not Allowed

1. Earrings on males
2. Visible tattoos
3. Unnatural hair colors

Summary

With modesty in mind, the dress code guidelines will be enforced.

Dresses may not be cut below the bust line.
