PreACT®

Students in 10th and 11th grade will be taking the PreACT on Wednesday, November 4th during 1-4 periods.

The **PreACT test** provides students with practice for the **ACT test** and measures progress towards college readiness. Mirroring the style of the official college entrance exam, this multiple-choice paper-based test features questions in four subject areas: English/language arts, math, reading, and science.
