- Be a student entering your 10th-12th grade year
- Recorded 20 hours of community service for each high school year you have been a student at IRCS. The IRCS Community Service Form must be submitted, filled out completely with date(s), the amount of time spent, activity, and signed by a supervising adult that is not your parent or close relative.

- To be considered for NHS, you must submit your application and community service hours NO LATER than 3:00 p.m. on Friday, August 11, 2023 by emailing it to: <u>ircs.honsocieties@ircs.org</u> or printing it out and submitting it to Mrs. Machelle' Stevens mailbox in the High School Office.

The IRCS Faculty Council will consider your NHS application in the following four areas: Character, Leadership, Service, and Scholarship. You will be notified of the results of the Faculty Council voting on or before Friday, September 8, 2023. If you are accepted, you are required to attend the Induction Ceremony held in the Worship Center on Monday, September 18, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.

Please remember no late applications will be accepted. They must be turned in NO LATER than 3:00 p.m. on Friday, August 11, 2023.
