Community Service Hours REQUIREMENT to be eligible to apply to NJHS:

- Minimum of 15 community service hours submitted to Student Services NO LATER than <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 11, 2023</u>. Community Service forms can be picked up from Student Services or downloaded from the Honor Societies' page at <u>ircs.org</u>.
- Services Hours MUST have been served between August 12, 2022 to August 11, 2023.
 *Reminder that you cannot be paid for any hours submitted as community service.

Examples of service hours are:

- Assisting a teacher or coach in a school or community activity
- Supervising or teaching younger students (i.e. Vacation Bible School, athletic camps, Camp Eagle, community summer camps & activities)
- Peer tutoring or coaching others your age
- Helping an older neighbor a single parent or a family with lawn care, cleaning, childcare, or pet care;
- Serving at a soup kitchen, homeless shelter, or food bank

This process is entirely your responsibility and it is not to be filled out by anyone but you. Please note every activity you are involved in both in and outside of IRCS. If you're not sure, include it — the faculty council will determine if it is relevant. Please be aware that completing the application process (getting everything filled out and turned in on time) does not ensure induction into the *National Junior Honor Society*. This is determined by a majority "yes" vote of the Faculty Council.
